Covid Management Plan

This document provides interim guidance for preventing the transmission of COVID-19 at Coquihalla Campground for employees and guests. To limit the spread of COVID-19, we will outline new measures put into place across all departments and will be revised as needed based on provincial direction. COQUIHALLA CAMPGROUND

Check In/Store:

- Guests with reservations are to check in at the office. All guests must wear a mask and stay 6ft apart. Hand Sanitizer is available at the entrance to the office.
- A plexiglass shield is on the check in desk to help minimize the risk of spread.
- Occupancy limits of 2 people at a time in the office/store.
- All guests will be required to sign a waiver with a code of conduct upon arrival
- Employees are on hand from 6:30am-11pm
- Covid-19 signage will be displayed on the office building
- All frequented touch points in the office will be sanitized multiple times throughout the day to continue to keep employees safe
- 6ft markers to be in place should any lineups occur

Washroom Building:

- Washrooms to be cleaned and disinfected twice daily
- Touch points will be sanitized multiple times throughout the day
- One person at a time/one household at a time- door to be locked during use
- 6ft markers will be in place should any line ups occur

COQUIHALLA CAMPGROUND

Shower Building:

- Showers and bathrooms to be cleaned and disinfected twice daily
- Touch points will be sanitized multiple times throughout the day
- A maximum of two people at a time in the main bathroom/shower
- One household or single occupant at a time in the single shower/bathroom stalls
- Registered guests will be recommended to bring their own clean kit (toilet paper, sanitizer and gloves)
- Sandals/flip flops to be worn at all times
- Strong recommendations will remain in place to use their own self-contained units
- 6 ft markers will be in place should line ups occur

Playground:

- Use at your own risk
- Playground equipment is not sanitized
- Sanitize/wash hands after use
- Space accordingly from others

COQUIHALLA CAMPGROUND

BBQ Shelter:

- One household at a time
- Cleaned and disinfected once daily
- Strong Recommendation to use own camper facilities

Work Truck/Golf Cart:

- Hand Sanitize before entry
- Disinfect touch points including steering wheel and gear shift before and after using
- Staff to use separate vehicles when available
- If to share vehicle, masks must be used at all times
- Vehicles are to be kept clean at all times

Sites:

- Each site is properly spaced
- Gloves are to be used when touching water tap and sani points
- Signs will be placed throughout the campground to remind guests of social distancing requirements
- Picnic tables, water taps and sani will be washed and disinfected between each use
- Visitors are strongly discouraged

-Campground gate at entry to the campground will be closed in the evenings to restrict locals/day users from entering the sites

General Safety:

- Each building will be equipped with hand sanitizer before entry
- Soap and paper towels are readily available in each facility
- Covid-19 signs to be posted throughout the campground and facilities

Employees:

- Employees will be given a training plan as per WorkSafe BC for cleaning and maintenance tasks. Employees will be required to wear the designated PPE for each task
- Employees must sign off on a daily health check to confirm they have no symptoms of Covid-19
- Employees must wear a mask when social distancing cannot be achieved
- Sanitize work station before and after each shift
